We welcome expressions of interest from individuals with:

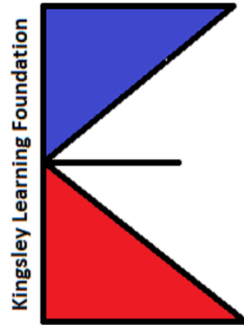
- A commitment to education and social impact
